à	<i>(a accent grave)</i>	control + `, then a
è	<i>(e accent grave)</i>	control + `, then e
ô	<i>(o accent circonflexe)</i>	control + shift + 6, then o
â	<i>(a accent circonflexe)</i>	control + shift + 6, then a
î	<i>(i accent circonflexe)</i>	control + shift + 6, then i
ï	<i>(i tréma)</i>	control + colon (:), then i
ë	<i>(e tréma)</i>	control + colon (:), then e
ç	<i>(c cédille)</i>	control = comma (,), then c
